# SINGAPORE PERMANENT RESIDENCE (PR)



## Eligibility

A current Employment Pass, Personalised Employment Pass, EntrePass or S Pass holder  
Have worked in Singapore for at least six months

## Benefit 1

You can conveniently enter and leave the country without having to apply a separate Singapore visas for work or travel.

## Benefit 2

Your spouse and unmarried children under 21 can be included in the PR application. Otherwise, they can become a Long-Term Visit Pass Holder if they meet the criteria.

## Benefit 3

You can enjoy the parenthood incentives (eg. Baby Bonus Scheme) if your child is a Singapore Citizen.

## Benefit 4

Your school age children will be placed high on the priority list, behind citizens, if you wish to enrol him/her in public schools. School fees will be at a subsidised rate.

## Benefit 5

You can change jobs freely without having to re-apply for a Singapore work permit. Minimise your risk of delay and rejection.



# SINGAPORE PERMANENT RESIDENCE (PR)

## Benefits 6

You will be under the Central Provident Fund (CPF) scheme which you and your employer will contribute a monthly minimum amount. This is subjected to tax relief.

## Benefit 7

You can use your CPF savings to fund your retirement, healthcare, and housing needs in Singapore.

## Benefit 8

You will have access to affordable healthcare in the public hospitals as cost differs with residency status. Your public healthcare is also subsidised.

## Benefit 9

You will get a higher priority to borrow various loans, such as housing loans to purchase property.

## Benefit 10

You are eligible to buy HDB resale flats (only Singapore citizens can purchase new flats).

## Benefit 11

You can apply for full Singapore citizenship and be entitled to the same rights after having permanent residence status for a number of years.

# SINGAPORE PERMANENT RESIDENCE (PR)



## Drawback 1

Your son (Second Generation Male PR) need to enlist for National Service (NS) and will serve two years of full-time NS at 18 years of age.

## Drawback 2

Contributions to CPF is mandatory. This is up to 20% of your monthly wage.

## Drawback 3

You can withdraw your savings as a lump sum only if you denounce your PR status.
